WHAT THEY ARE DOING

The museum is saving on their CO2 emissions by installing new energy efficient heating systems throughout the site, whilst also improving the building's thermal properties by investing in secondary glazing systems and insulation.

Other systems reduce the water used by both staff and visitors, as well as exploring ways of harvesting water efficiently to use elsewhere. They're also exploring carbon offsetting schemes to create green spaces within the site for the health and wellbeing of staff and visitors, whilst also encouraging wildlife.
