## WHAT THEY ARE DOING

The Trust is helping to protect and support communities be resilient to the impacts of climate change.

They're expanding the generation of energy from their network – including hydro-schemes, solar panels, and water-source heat pumps – as well as trialling biofuels.

The canal is also the main blue-green corridor in central Nottingham, helping people enjoy active travel by walking or cycling.

By changing towpath verge management near London Road and introducing floating reedbeds at Castle Wharf, wildlife is being supported in the city.
